

















Rack Heat Warning

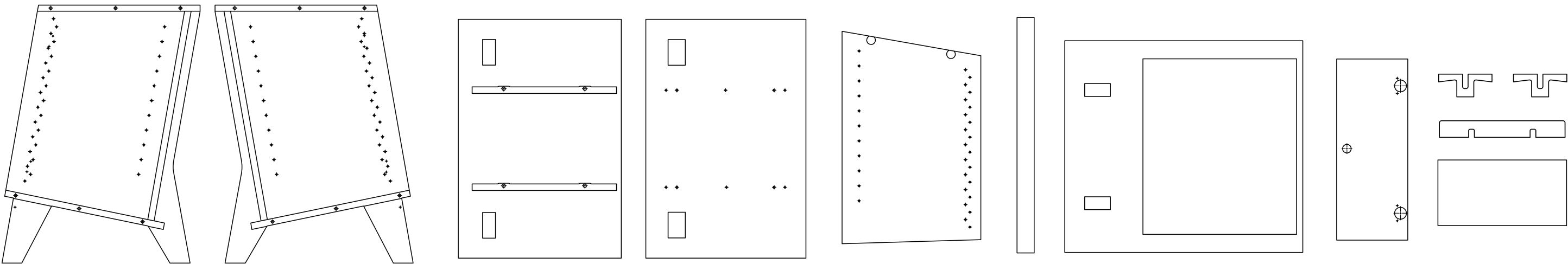
